




**SUSTAINABILITY COMMITTEE

 - Update and discussion on the Council action taken on Agreement with PG&E to administer the Clothes Washer Rebate Program – This agreement will allow PG&E to manage the clothes washer rebate program and provide greater marketing of the program. PG&E will pay \$50 of the rebate and overall it would drop the rebate from \$250 to \$150 with the agreement beginning Feb 1, 2016
 - Discussion on updating the Toilet Rebate Program
 - Discussion on updating the Smart Yard (Irrigation Controller) Program
 - Discussion on the creation of a Cash for Grass Program
 - General discussion on current water conservation programs and future programs.
