## St. Helena Street Repairs and Maintenance 2013 Project Underway



When you come across the above sign as you travel around the city, it is a sign that good things are happening in your community. Your Public Works Department, along with contractor Argonaut Constructors, began digging out, grinding and paving operations on 21 different streets throughout the St. Helena community on Monday, September 23rd. More than \$1 million is being spent to upgrade local streets.

Each street will be receiving one of the following treatments or a combination thereof: crack-sealing, microsurfacing and/or re-paving. During construction, drivers can expect minor delays and convenient detours. Residents along these sections of street will be asked to have their vehicles moved off of the street so that equipment has access to all portions of the street. Notification of pending work will come via door-hangers placed at each residence affected along the scheduled work route. Traffic will continue to flow through each work zone, but drivers are asked to use caution around workers and equipment.




