**SUSTAINABILITY COMMITTEE – Two Alternate Positions**

Two alternate terms of office are for two years, upon appointment through June 30, 2017.

The mission of the Sustainability Committee is to educate St. Helena citizens, businesses, city staff and elected officials and assist with reasonable measures to achieve greenhouse gas reduction and effective sustainability practices. The Committee strives to make St. Helena programs a model of sustainability for the state.

**ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE – One Position & One Alternate Position**

One term of office is for one year, upon appointment through June 30, 2016. One alternate term of office is for two years, upon appointment through June 30, 2017.

The committee is to function in an advisory capacity to direct its activities to improving bicycling, walking and other active modes of transportation within the City of St. Helena.

**MULTI- CULTURAL COMMITTEE – One Position**

One term of office is for one year, upon appointment through June 30, 2016.

The Multi-Cultural Committee encourages and facilitates Hispanic community involvement in city issues. The Committee promotes cultural awareness and a literacy program to promote active, successful, language-proficient community members.
